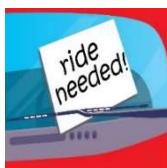
Women's "DIVINE DESTINATIONS" Retreat Saturday, February 24 @ 9am **LAST SUNDAY TO SIGN UP!**

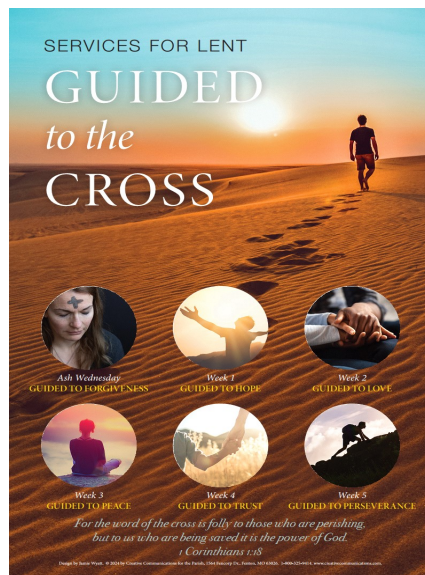

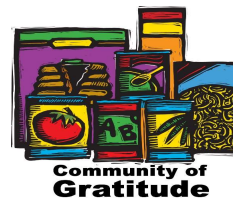
