Christian Freedom Celebration Service

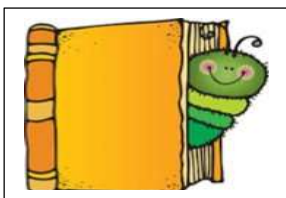
